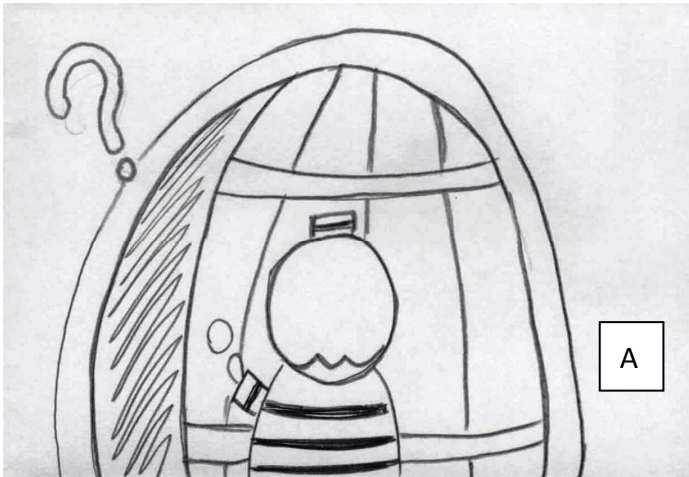

Which came out of that door, the lady or the tiger?



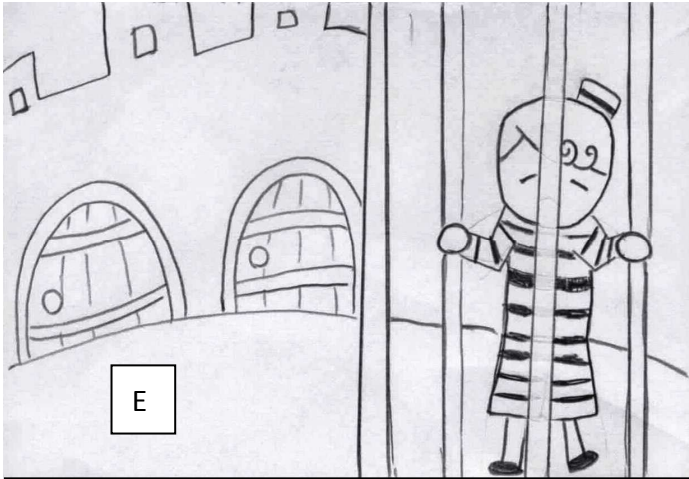

The man was immediately cast into prison, and soon came the day when he too had to appear for his "trial" in the king's arena.

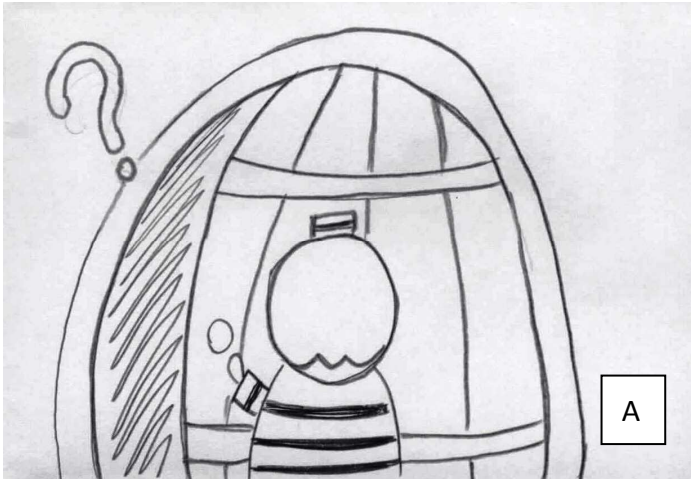


The king had a daughter...She had taken a handsome young man as her secret lover. However, one day they were seen kissing each other.

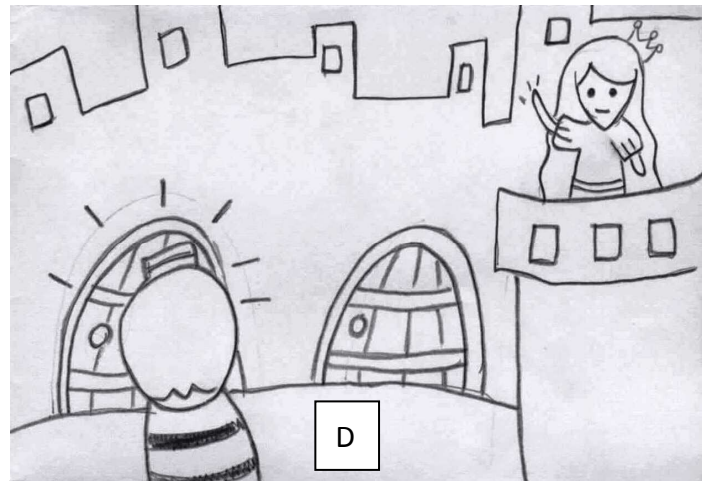
